THANKSGIVING will be here soon. Please bring Thanksgiving type food for the Food Bank, so the less fortunate may have a good Thanksgiving dinner too.



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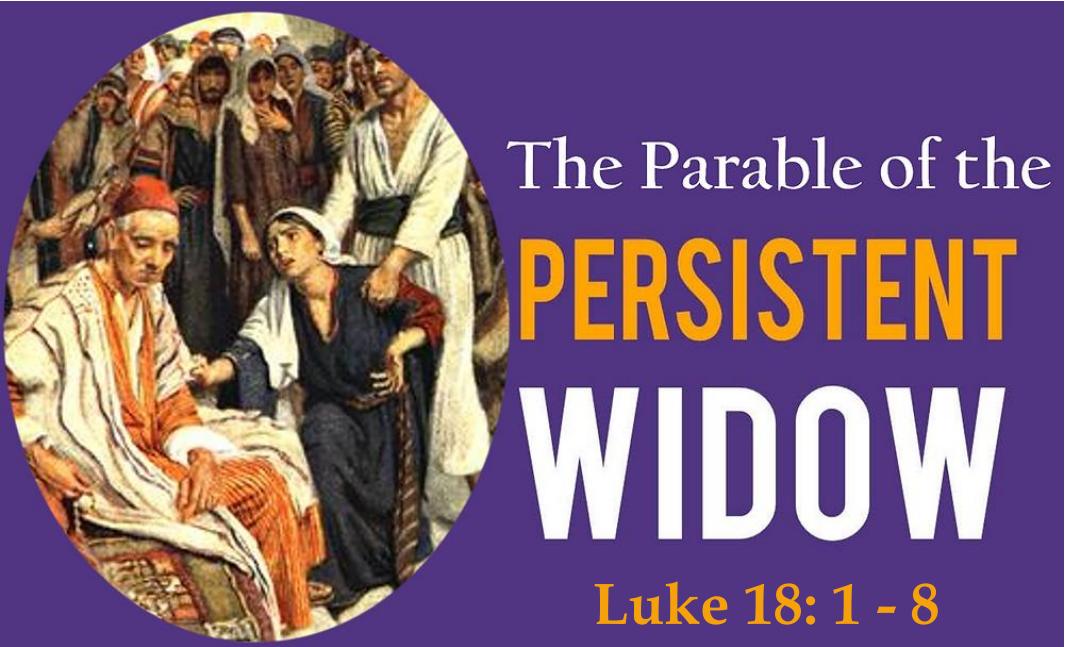
