

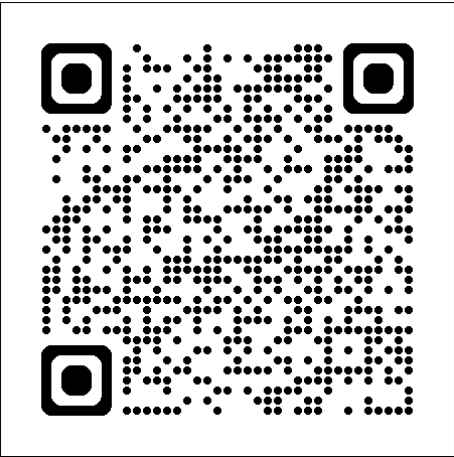
FLOWERS:

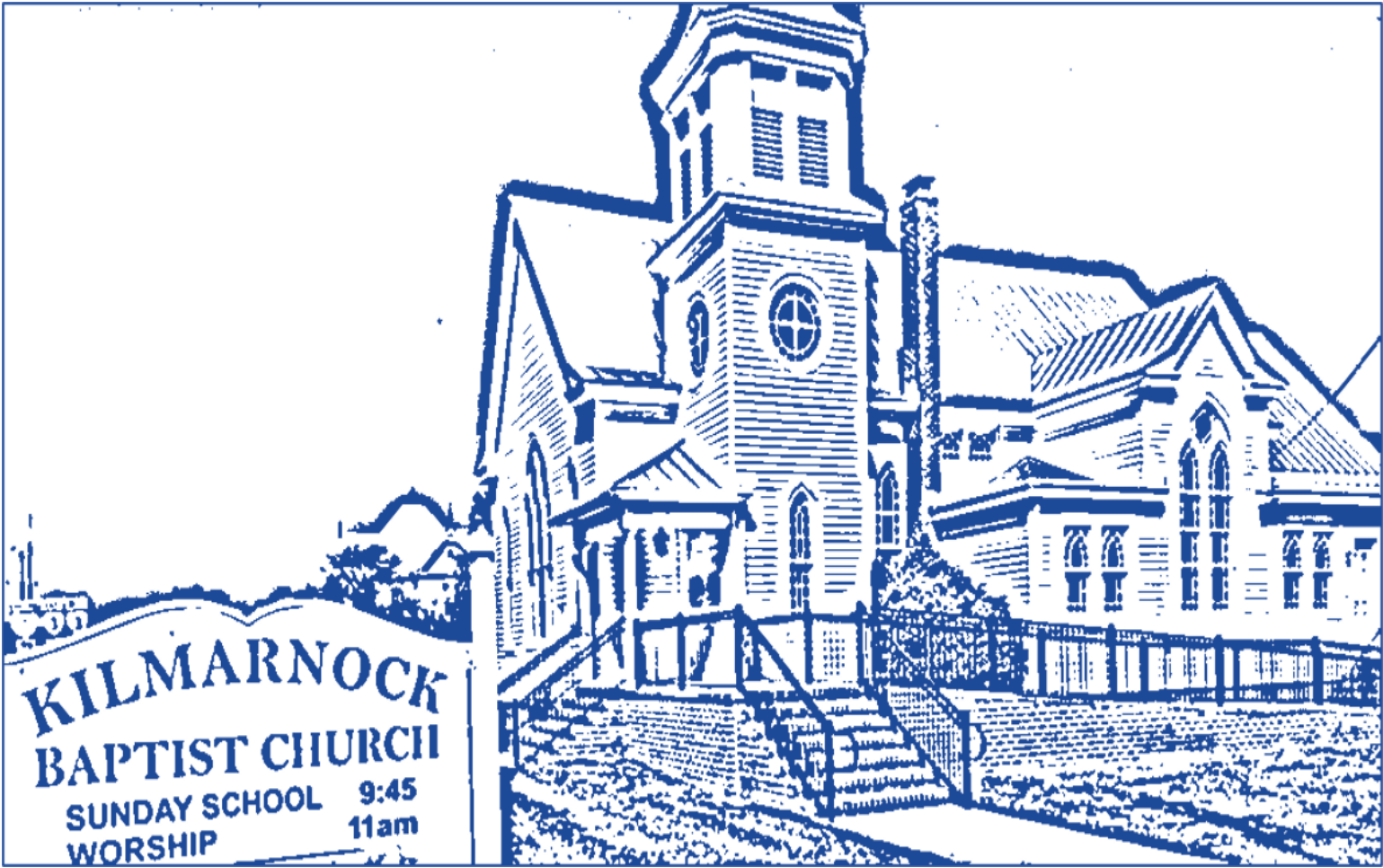
